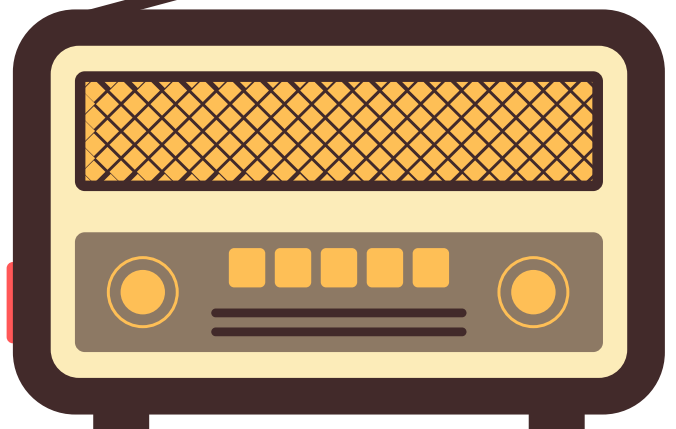
There will be drag performances, karaoke, and even a photo booth! Bring your friends and support two student organizations right on campus.
