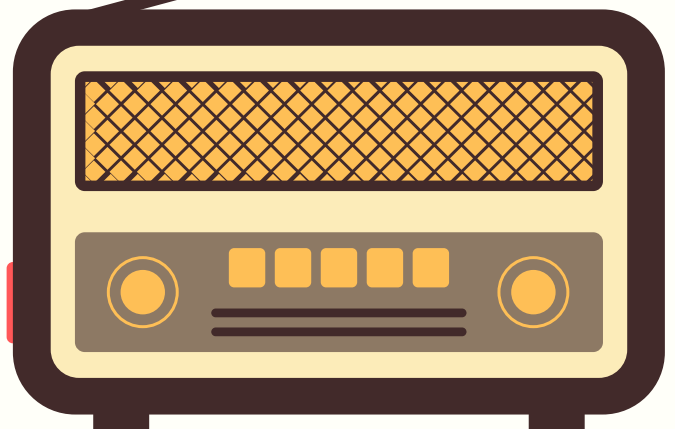
## VALENTINES FUNDRAISER RESULTS

Through out each semester, we submit what is called an IP List to the FCC. This is essentially local, national, or global news that all stations are required to report on. WCRD is no exception to this. All shows are required to report on at least ONE submission each show (this can include pop culture news!) by using the QR code located in Studio A.

Make sure you are not plagiarizing others work. Reading out someone else's article in its entirety can be classified as plagiarism. Summarizing is the best way to go!

Submitting an IP List is what ensure our station stays up and running. You're help is vital to the future of the station.
